

SUBMITTING YOUR FILMS ONTO CHEW TV FOR GYFF 2010

Submission criteria:

- Entries must be one minute (60 seconds) long or less, including titles and credits.
- Competition is open to 14 – 19 year olds, as groups or individuals.
- Applicants should clearly state if they are submitting their entry on behalf of a **group** or as an **individual** in the description of the film.
- Entrants must also send a link to Paul Macgregor by email info@gft.org.uk by that date.
- Completed entries must be uploaded to Chew TV website by 12pm on **Thursday 28 January 2009 by 6pm.**
- Remember to a fully completed a submission form!
- You must include the line 'GYFF' in the title of the film.
- Stay safe and don't try any dangerous stunts!
- Please don't film actors in school uniforms or against school logos. Any entry featuring school uniforms or logos will be rejected.
- All entries may be used by Glasgow Youth Film Festival for promotional purposes on their website.
- All entries must additionally comply with Chew TV's Terms and Conditions (<http://www.chewtv.com/Pages/TandCs.aspx>), please read these carefully before entering.
- Glasgow Youth Film Festival reserves the right to withdraw entries and any prizes offered.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING

Register for Chew TV

The first thing you need to do is register as a new user for Chew TV.

Please go to www.chewtv.com and click 'Register' in the top half of the page. Once you have received your confirmation email, you are ready to submit your entry.

If you have previously registered for Chew TV, please click 'Login' and enter your details.

Online submissions

If a film is under 200mb you can submit simply online, we can accept files of types: **.flv, .mpg, .wma, .mp4, .mpeg, or .mov**

1. Sign in and select the 'submit film' icon, if you are under 18 years old please get a parent or responsible adult to enter their email address confirming they take responsibility for the submission.
2. Enter the details for the film in the sections provided; make sure you put 'GYFF' in the film's title.
3. Select 'Chew TV' when asked which channel the film is for.
4. Upload the film
5. You will receive an email to let you know if your film upload has been successful.

Postal submissions

We accept file times: Quicktime DV-PAL data file on DVD or other transferable media

1. Follow the instructions 1-3 for online submissions
2. Once you have entered the details select that you wish to submit via post, a code will appear on the screen, please note down this code.
3. Send the film into the following address; **please remember to quote the code.**

Things to remember before submitting content:

A person over eighteen should submit all content. If you are under eighteen please get a parent or responsible adult to submit their email address to confirm they oversee the submission.

Chew TV has a very strict copyright policy

This means that Chew TV is unable to accept any films that contain music and images unless you've had permission from the producer! So unless you're able to prove consent from your favourite band, you'll have to stick to the free music offered by the many sites like Humtoo.
